

BELFAST HILLS BIOLOGICAL SURVEY WORK EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

Information Required from Respondents

The Belfast Hills Partnership has secured funding for a range of biodiversity projects including a variety of biological survey work to be carried on upland heathland and on the Irish hare in the Belfast Hills. We will also be seeking further funding for other Belfast Hills biodiversity projects in the near future.

We therefore intend to create select lists of suitable contractors who will in turn be asked to submit tenders for survey contracts as they arise.

To be considered for inclusion in these select lists, potential contractors are asked to submit the following information:-

1. Area or areas of biological survey work for which they would wish to be considered
2. Contact details and details of staff and any existing or potential partners/subcontractors
3. Their relevant experience and qualifications in these areas to date
4. Insurance Details – e.g. Public Liability, Employee and Professional Indemnity as appropriate
5. Any other information such as client testimonials.

The Partnership will duly compile Select Lists based strictly on the above supplied information.

We require these Expressions of Interest to be submitted either electronically or by hard copy (5 copies) by 4pm 22/6/07.
