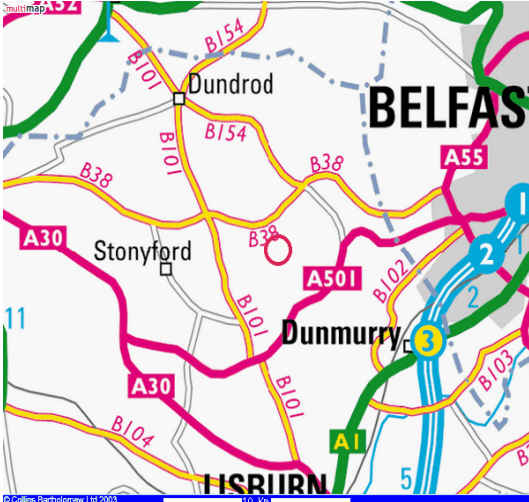


SLIEVENACLOY DIRECTIONS



From Belfast

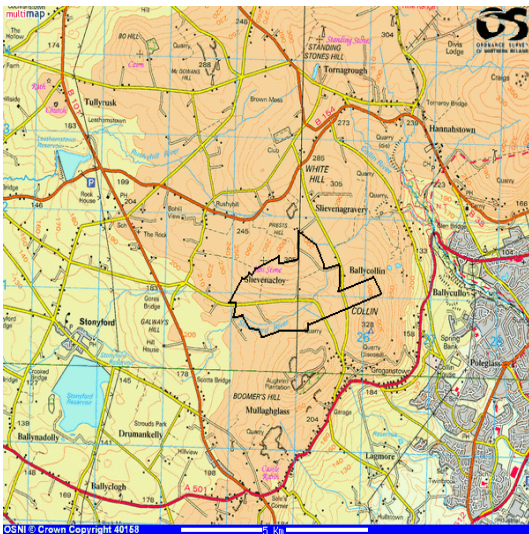
- Get yourself onto the Colin Glen Road (A501) heading towards Lisburn.
- On the right side of the road just past Groganstown is the Colin Glen Filling Station.
- Turn right just before this onto the Ballycolin Road.
- After about half a mile, take a left onto the Flowbog Road.

From Lisburn

- Take the airport road (B101)
- At the junction with the Colin Glen Road (A501) where you will see the White Mountain Filling Station on the left hand side, take right turn.
- After about two miles you will see the Glen Colin Filling station on your left.
- Take a left turn just after the garage onto the Ballycolin Road.
- After about half a mile, take a left onto the Flowbog Road.

From The North

- Take the B101 towards Lisburn.
- About 4 miles south of Dundrod you will pass the Ballymac Hotel on the right hand side of the road.
- About one mile further south you will see a sign indicating a minor road on the left hand side. Take this turning (the Flowbog Road)
- After about half a mile you will see signs indicating that you have entered the Slievenacloy Reserve.

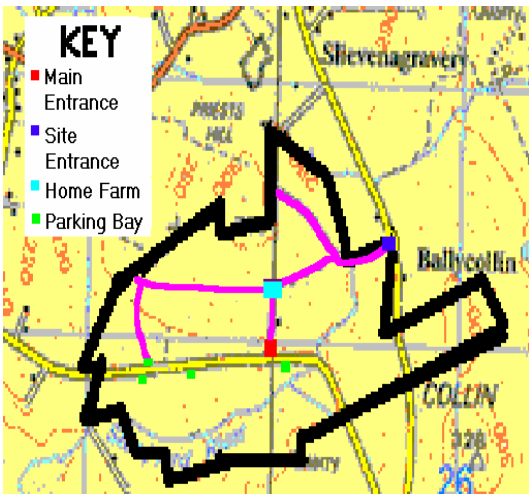


Once on site

- Park in any of the gateway parking bays on the Flowbog Road.
- Head for Home Farm, up the hill from the Main Entrance.
- There are waymarked trails and an orientation leaflet to help you explore the site available at Home Farm.

Be Aware!

- There are no toilet facilities.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Cattle are free to roam in the fields.
- Wear stout shoes and take weatherproof clothing as conditions are very changeable and the site is very exposed.
